Turn on "Info" under View menu so that when you mouse over anything in Live you see a detailed explanation about it in the lower lefthand corner.

Turn on "Help View" under View menu so that a new sidebar window opens on right side with many quick tips open up. I strongly suggest taking the "Tour of Live" which has you open up a completed song with audio clips and quickly walks you through how audio is played and created in Ableton.
